## American Bill of Rights

First Amendment

Provides a speedy and public trial by jury



Second Amendment

Provides each state with powers that are not specifically assigned to the nation's government in the Constitution



Third Amendment

States that no one's rights should be used to infringe on the rights of another



Fourth Amendment

Prevents those accused of suffering cruel and unusual punishment



Fifth Amendment

Grants the right to bear arms



Sixth Amendment

Grants the freedom of speech, freedom of press, freedom of assembly, and the right to protest



Seventh Amendment

States that soldiers cannot take over a home during war or peace without the owner's permission



Eighth Amendment

Protects against unreasonable and unlawful search and seizure of property



Ninth Amendment

Allows a trial by jury to be held for certain civil disputes



Tenth Amendment

Allows all citizens due process
