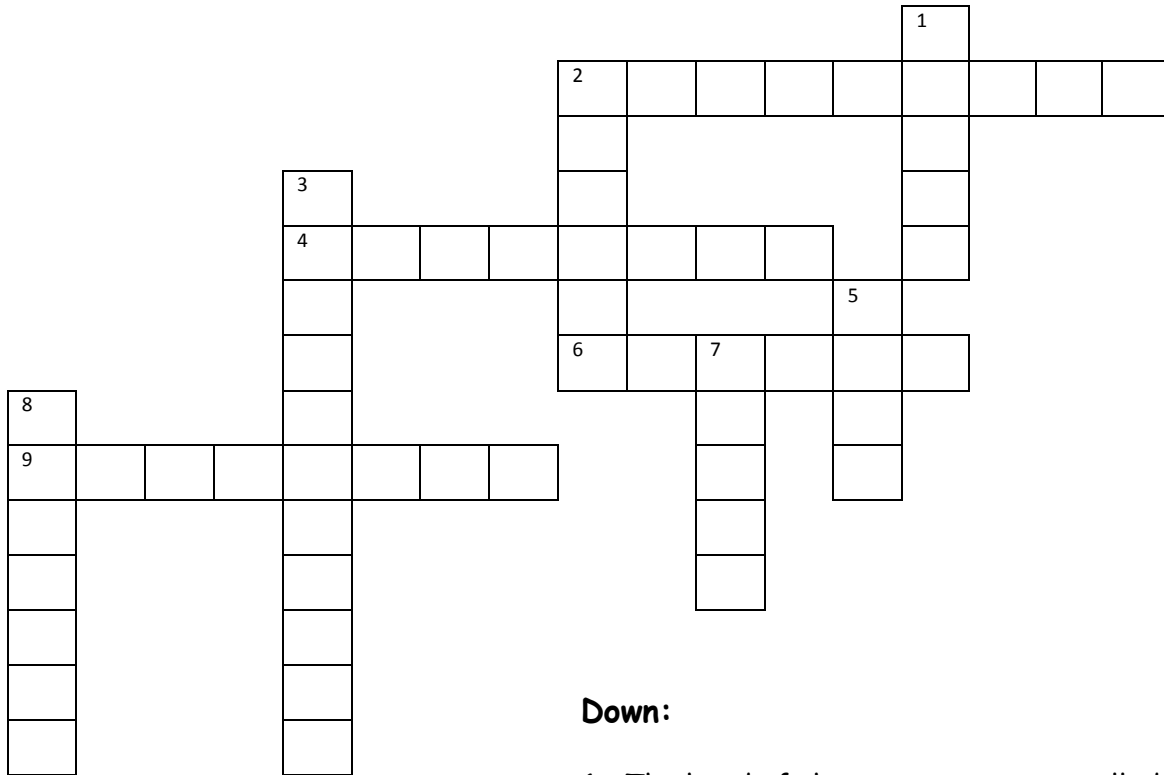

- 9. Skilled craftsmen who created beautiful sculptures

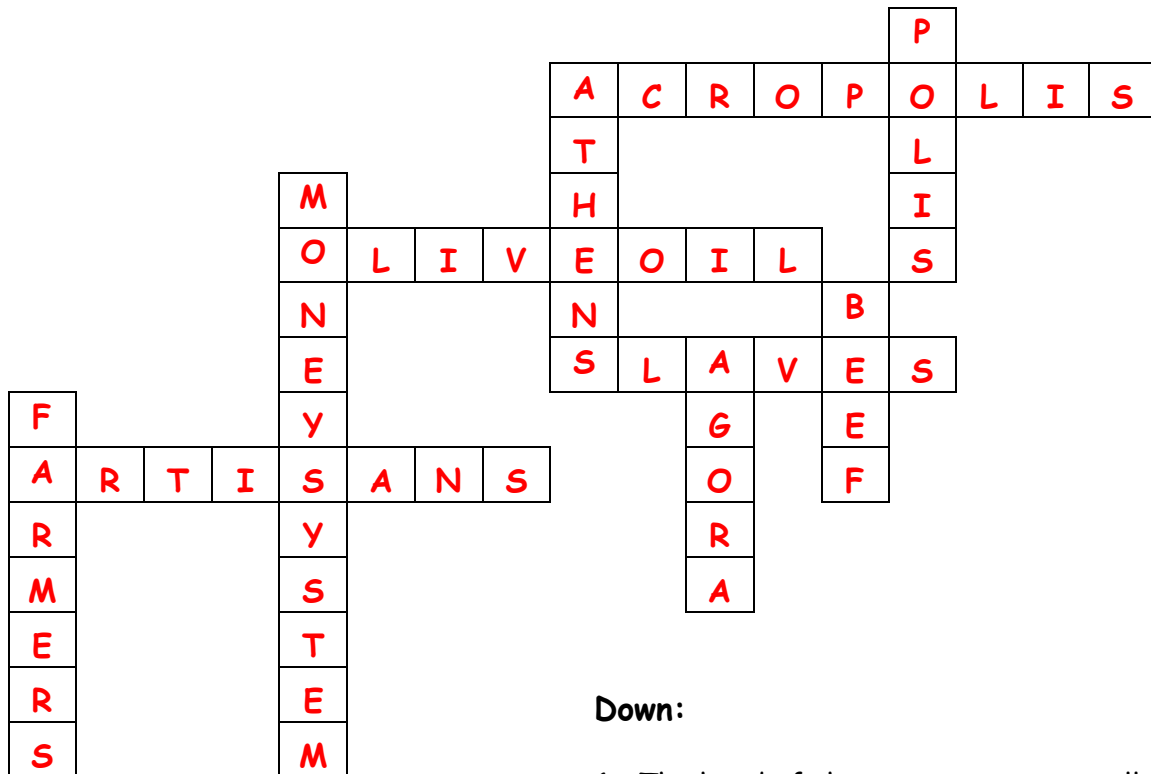
Down:
